

2009 Greens Action Plan

- #7 green will be re-sodded as soon as possible using L-93 bentgrass. The usable turf from #7 will be reused to fix #6 and other areas until the sod runs out.
- #5 and the putting green will be allowed to grow in and mature. A mid June date of opening is scheduled.
- A grow-in fertility program will be used on the remaining greens this fall. We need to reestablish the surface density of bentgrass on all greens before *Poa annua* germinates.
- Any dead spots on the greens that did not recover enough for play will be sodded in the fall.
- Monthly applications of deep solid tine aeration will start in early spring, at a minimum depth of 6 to 8 inches.
- Regular spring aerification will include an additional a drill-and-fill procedure. This will be done every spring for three years, and then every fall for the next three years.
- The greens will be vented with ¼ inch solid tines every three weeks
- The greens will be spiked weekly
- The greens will be lightly dusted with top-dressing weekly
- There will be a mid-season core aerification without sand using quadratine 5/16 inch coring tines. The greens will be rolled immediately following to prepare for play.

During mid-summer an assessment will be made on the condition of the greens and another action plan will be formulated.
