BULK SPRING CLEAN UP 2026

Monday April 20th thru Thursday April 23rd

Greetings Lake Monticello Members,

GFL Environmental will be conducting our annual curbside "BULK SPRING CLEAN UP" service starting Monday April 20th through Thursday April 23rd with Friday April 24th as a roll over day. Our crews will start at 7am Monday in the designated Monday service area. The crews will do their best to stay on schedule but if an area is not completed on the designated day, the crew will start the next day in that area to finish before starting the next area. Friday will be an overflow day if needed. With the high demand every year for this service, the crews will not be able to come back if they have already completed the street or area. Please see attached service day map for your service area day.

You may dispose of regular household items such as small furniture, bags of trash, leaf bags, small metal items such as toasters, small televisions, etc. Please limit your materials to weigh no more than **50lbs** per item and no longer than 5'. Please take the time to review the list of excluded materials below to save time and to help keep the community clean after we have completed the bulk pickup.

Any **EXCLUDED ITEMS** that are placed out for the service will be left and be the responsibility of the member to remove off the curbside within 24 hours after the service has been completed for the designated area.

Please have all acceptable items for bulk pickup out to the curb by no later than 7am on your designated service day. We do highly suggest to have items out the day or night before so your items will be picked up during the service.

*****ALL BULK MATERIALS MUST BE AT THE CURB*****

All material is removed by hand not by machine.

Please keep this in mind when placing items at curbside.

MATERIALS EXCLUDED FROM THE BULK PICK UP SERVICES:

- * Computers, printers, monitors and/or like equipment.
- * Mattresses, box springs, large appliances such as washer, dryer, water heater, dishwasher, stove, refrigerator, freezer, A/C unit, and/or motorized equipment as well as items containing freon.
- * Rocks, concrete, dirt, tires, soil, sod, tree stumps, any type of construction trash/renovation debris such as insulation, lumber, drywall, landscaping timbers, and/or friable asbestos.
- * Free liquids, paint and/or paint cans with paint in them as well as spray paint cans, motor oil, lead acid/wet cell batteries, biohazardous material, needles, lead acid/wet cell batteries and/or ALL other medical waste.
- * Combustibles, toxic and/or hazardous wastes, any other material excluded from the disposal site, hazardous and/or toxic materials (asbestos, paint, or gasoline). As well as all flammable products such as petrol chemicals and/or propane tanks from barbeque grills, dead animals, fecal matter, manure.
